REFUNDS & CLASS CHANGES

A \$10.00 fee will be charged for each refund request, regardless of the date requested. A fee of \$25.00 or 25% (whichever is less will be charged) if requested between 1-5 business days before the start of the activity. A fee of 50% will be charged if requested on the start date of the activity and before the 2nd meeting date. No refunds will be accepted after the 2nd meeting date. Tryouts are considered the starting date for athletic programs. The 1st practice is considered the 2nd meeting date for athletic programs.

Refund request forms can be filled out online by clicking on the refund request form link from the registration login page. Forms are also available in all Recreation Centers. **Phone-in requests will not be accepted.**

A \$5 fee will be charged for all class change requests.

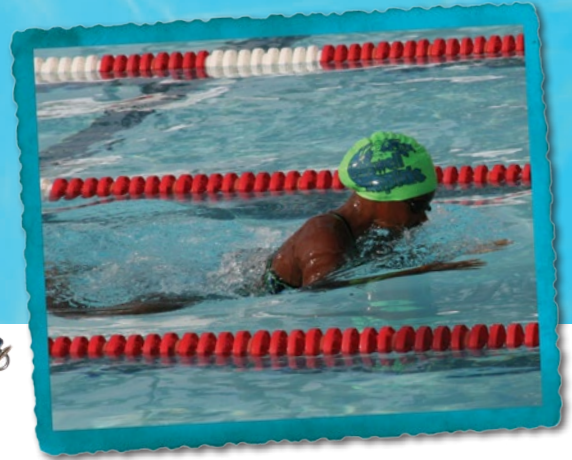

LESSON DESCRIPTIONS



SWIM LESSONS

Participants may be registered for only one class at a time. After completion of a class, participants may register for another. It is common for a swimmer to repeat a class level, thus, this policy helps in signing up a swimmer for the correct level.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CLASSES ARE HELD RAIN OR SHINE

All swim classes meet for a two-week period from Tuesday through Friday, unless otherwise noted, at the Roswell Area Park Pool. Only registered participants are allowed in the pool area during swim lessons. Parents will be allowed in the pool area for observation on the last day of class. When a parent is required in the water with a child, no other children or infants are allowed to remain on the deck. The age control date is the child's age on 9/1/14.

SWIM LESSON FEES

\$54, residents \$81, non-residents

A fee of \$10 will be charged for each refund and/or class change for swim classes. Requests must be made prior to the first day of class. No refunds or class changes will be made after a class begins. Classes are held rain or shine!

PARENT / CHILD WATER FUN - 45015

Ages 2-1/2 - 3

This class shows you how to prepare your toddler for a safe aquatic experience through fun and water games introducing blowing bubbles, kicking and other basic skills. One or both parents required in water with the child at all times.

This class does not teach your toddler how to swim.

LEVEL 1 - WATER EXPLORATION - 45016

Ages 4 - 5

Designed to let children have fun in the water while they develop swimming readiness. *No parent required.*

LEVEL 2 - BEGINNER - 45017

Ages 5 & Up

Focuses on primary skills expanding aquatic locomotion and safety skill. *Prerequisite: Must have accomplished skills taught in Level 1.*

LEVEL 3 - ADVANCED BEGINNER - 45018

Ages 6 & Up

Focuses on stroke readiness, increasing swimming skill competency. Practice of safety and rescue skills. *Prerequisite: Must have accomplished skills taught in Level 2, including swimming on back (10 feet) and swimming independently 15 feet with face in the water.*

LEVEL 4 - INTERMEDIATE - 45019

Ages 6 & Up

Focus on stroke development working to develop confidence and competency in strokes and safety skills beyond preceding levels. Teaches the breast stroke and side stroke. *Prerequisite: Must be able to swim 25 yards unassisted.*

LEVEL 5 - SWIMMER - 45020

Ages 6 & Up

Focus on stroke refinement with continuous refinement of front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, and sidestroke. Introduction of butterfly, surface dives and springboard diving. *Prerequisite: Must have accomplished skills taught in Level 4.*

LEVEL 6 - ADVANCED SWIMMER - 45021

Ages 6 & Up

Focus on skill proficiency working to develop maximum efficiency and endurance for strokes. Introduces surface dives and flip turns. *Prerequisite: Must have accomplished skills taught in Level 5.*

ADULT SWIM LESSONS - 45025

Ages 16 & Up

Designed for adults who are interested in learning to swim. Course teaches floating, navigating and use of proper strokes in the water. *Prior swimming experience is not required.*

Other amenities at Don White Memorial Park include outdoor exercise equipment, accessible restrooms, fishing dock and access to the Roswell River Walk.





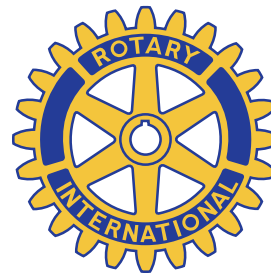

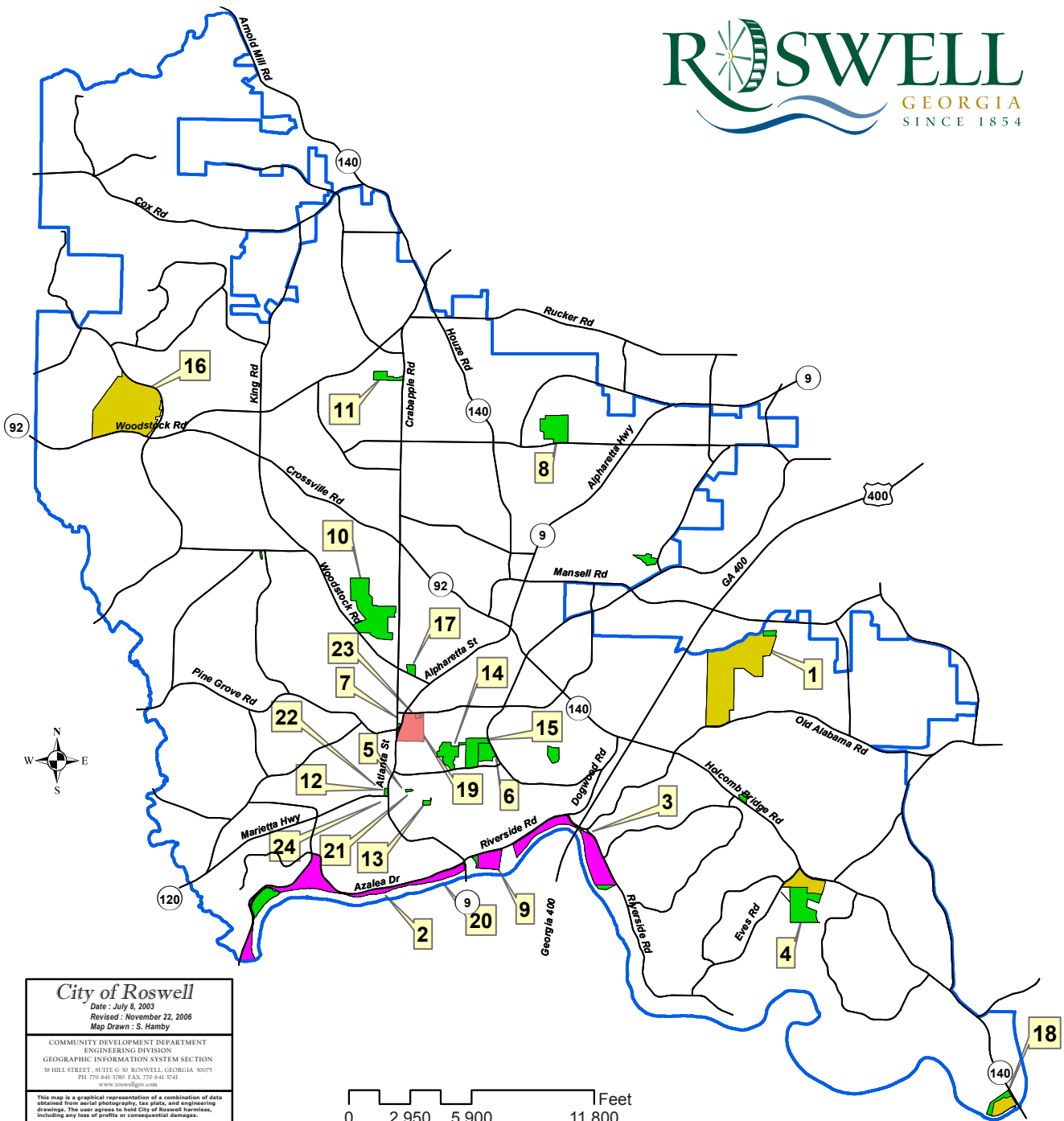
